HONOLULU – The Honolulu Symphony is thrilled to announce that Grammy-award-winning jazz pianist and vocalist Diana Krall will join Maestro Matt Catingub and the Honolulu Symphony Pops on Sunday, May 8, 2005 at 7:00 p.m. at the Waikiki Shell. This special, one-night-only presentation features Krall together under the stars with Hawaii's own Grammy-nominated Honolulu Symphony Pops. Jazz's top selling vocalist, Krall selected this concert with Catingub and the Honolulu Symphony Pops as the final stop on her current world tour.

Krall's popular program of standards, ballads and bossa novas includes such classics as Peggy Lee's "I Love Being Here with You," Frank Sinatra's "Fly Me to the Moon," Cole Porter's "Let's Fall in Love," Irving Berlin's "Let's Face the Music and Dance" and "How Deep Is the

Ocean (How High Is the Sky),” and George and Ira Gershwin’s “They Can’t Take That Away from Me,” plus Louis Jordan’s “Is You Is or Is You Ain’t My Baby,” Joni Mitchell’s “A Case of You” and Billy Joel’s “Just the Way You Are.”

One of the most gifted musicians of her generation, Krall is a crossover phenomenon who has remained faithful to her bop and swing roots. Her hit albums include *Only Trust Your Heart; All for You: A Dedication to the Nat "King" Cole Trio; Love Scenes; When I Look in Your Eyes*, which spent 52 weeks in the #1 position on Billboard’s jazz chart and won two GRAMMYS; *The Look of Love*; and *The Girl In The Other Room*, which features new interpretations of modern standards by Tom Waits, Mose Allison, and Joni Mitchell, as well as compositions by Krall and husband, Elvis Costello.

Tickets for Diana Krall and the Honolulu Symphony Pops go on sale Saturday, February 26 at 9 a.m. at the Blaisdell Box Office and all Ticketmaster outlets or online at www.ticketmaster.com. Diana Krall tickets are \$38 for General Admission on the lawn, \$78 for Second Terrace Reserved Seating, \$93 for First Terrace Reserved Seating and \$128 for a Pool Area Table Seat. Wait service will be offered in the pool area for no additional charge and a special menu of delicious pupus will be available in the pool area for an additional \$15/person (call 792-2000 for menu information).

The 2005-2006 Honolulu Symphony Halekulani MasterWorks series and the 2005-2006 Honolulu Symphony Hawaiian Airlines Pops series will be announced later this month. Both series run from September 2005 to May 2006.
